Colorado Belle has rooms aboard the boat and two towers, offering over **1,167 hotel rooms**, many with spectacular views. Aboard the "boat", the Belle has **49 suites**, each with either a jacuzzi-type tub or massaging, multiple-head shower, two velour robes, and many other amenities to make your stay even more special. Desert Dust be Damned. The Beer is here! The Boiler Room Brew Pub, a multi-million dollar expansion to the Colorado Belle Hotel Casino, opened its doors in July 1997 to the clanging of chilled mugs, the ring of video poker machines, and aromas of grilled food and mesquite. Located on the casino level of the resort, the Boiler Room is a fully operational brewery, with an annual capacity of 155,000 gallons. It adds about 5,000 square feet to the casino, with seating for 280. The Boiler Room is set in a "belly of the boat" theme, reminiscent of "20,000 Leagues Under the Sea."

The Boiler Room Brew Pub also is Colorado Belle's award-winning microbrewery. Enjoy your favorite sports on our state-of-the-art digital audio-visual satellite system and 22 viewing screens. The Brew Pub serves fantastic meals and snacks from an award-winning menu. Don't forget to pick up a fine cigar from "Gifts on Tap", the Boiler Room's logo gift shop.

The Boiler Room's "open-pit" kitchen is a rarity in Laughlin. Featuring wood-fired ovens and open mesquite grilling, the Pub's specialties include Italian pies from wood-fired pizza ovens, Herb Seasoned Salmon, Drunkard Rib Eye Steak, gourmet hamburgers, fire-roasted specialties, and a variety of appetizers, steaks, sandwiches and desserts.



Brewing our own



The Brewing process and mini-tours of the facility are an interesting highlight of a visit to the Pub. The glass-encased copper brewing and serving tanks are especially impressive to those visiting their very first micro-brewery.

The equipment at the Belle includes six serving tanks, each holding 17 "barrels," and the beer is brewed in five tanks, with a total capacity of about 3,700 gallons.

In addition to lots of exciting amenities in the Boiler Room, the pub includes a full-service bar, with dessert cocktails, and, of course, hand-crafted brews, produced by Colorado Belle's brewing staff.

Beer, like cookies, is made in "Batches."

At the Boiler Room, one Brew Kettle "Batch" contains 17 barrels, equal to 34 kegs of beer. The monthly capacity of the pub is 12,911 gallons of suds. Over the course of a year, production can

reach 154,938 gallons. In addition to the hand-crafted brews produced by the amazing array of equipment, the Boiler Room serves domestic and imported beer, a host of specialty drinks, wine, and dessert cocktails. The Boiler Room also has a shopping area offering a select line of merchandise including The "Boiler Room Collection".

Laughlin's newest hot spot, serving the best in hand-crafted brew, damns the Mohave Desert dust seven days a week.

Golden Ale

Golden Ale is an old friend, a true American beauty. It's a classic pale ale, lightly hopped, subtle, clean, crisp, and refreshing. Light bodied, Golden Ale is a perfect companion on a hot Mohave Desert Day, or with a delicious meal. Good friends are hard to come by. Don't miss an opportunity to make another. Here's to good friends, old and new.



Amber Ale

Malty, amber-colored, pleasantly robust and mildly hopped, Amber Ale was originally a European "Workin' Man's Beer." But, nineteenth-century Europeans, from the Aristocrat to the hod carrier alike, soon discovered that this slightly dry "Workin' Man's Beer" tastes great. Whatever your walk in life, Amber Ale is the perfect toast to the "workin' man."

Stout

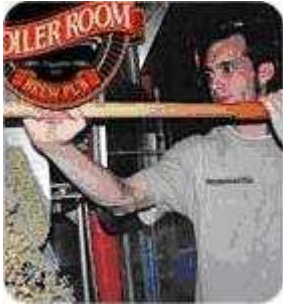
Brewmaster's Choice

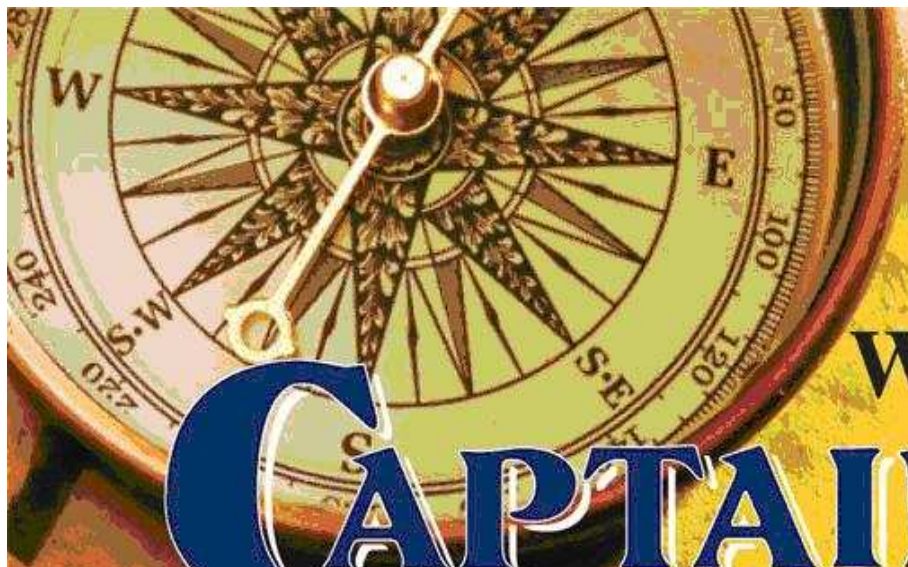
